Named "beautiful place by the sea" by the Abenaki Indians, Ogunquit is a year round vacation destination. Enjoy over three miles of white sand **beaches**, voted among the ten best beaches in the United States. **Historic Ogunquit village** offers a unique assortment of distinctive specialty shops and restaurants. Take a stroll along the breathtaking **Marginal Way**, a one-mile scenic footpath bordering the Atlantic Ocean. Picturesque **Perkins Cove**, the town's working harbor, provides a number of scenic cruises, sailing and deep-sea fishing excursions in season. Art enthusiasts will savor the numerous galleries in town, along with the **Ogunquit Museum of American Art**, home to approximately 1,500 pieces of twentieth century American work including paintings, sculpture, photography and graphics. The **Ogunquit Playhouse**, open late-June through August, has entertained audiences with a collection of live dramas, musicals and comedies since 1933. **Sporting** fans will find the area offers a number of golf courses, kayaking and public tennis courts.

Want to explore? Located ten miles to our south, **Kittery** is host to 120 outlet shops. **Kennebunkport**, an historic village offering an array of specialty shops, boutiques and restaurants, is ten miles to the north. **Freeport**, 50 miles to our north, is the home of L.L. Bean. The shops and museums of **Portland** and **Portsmouth, New Hampshire** are also just a short distance away from Ogunquit.

Directions

For travelers heading north: Follow I-95 over the bridge into Maine and continue for five miles to Exit 7, the last before toll. Take this exit and follow Route 1 north 7 miles to Ogunquit. Continue through village on Route 1 to the Juniper Hill Inn, just north of town center on your right.

For travelers heading south on I-95: Take Exit 19 at Wells, turn left on Route 109 and follow to Route 1. Turn right on Route 1 and travel five miles south to the Juniper Hill Inn on your left.
